For years, consumers have requested the development of a Drop-In Center in Somerset County.

In January 2015, BHSSBC conducted a needs assessment of mental health consumers in Somerset County. Ninety consumers participated in the survey and over 85% of the respondents stated that they were looking for a safe place to participate in social activities with their peers.

The successful opening of a Drop-In Center in Somerset County is due to the persistence of the mental health consumers who joined together to use their combined voice to respectfully and assertively request a Drop-In Center and to the number of consumers who responded to the survey stating that they would participate if a Drop-In Center would open in Somerset.

Community based recovery support services were once extremely lacking in our rural area. **Our Place** will finally address the significant gap that exists in community services and in the overall continuum of care.

Our Place is a Drop-In Center that provides a welcoming environment as well as a wide range of activities including recreational events, social events, support groups, and linkages with support services.
